November 15: Sunday morning Go-To-Church at the Sikh Center in Santa Ana.

Brittany has chosen a very different cultural experience for the go-to-church required activity.

Meet at the Bethel at 9:30 and bring some money for the offering and fast food for lunch, \$5-\$10...(\$1-\$2 dollars for the church offering. You need to wear a plain colored tee top WITH SLEEVES that will go with a gypsy skirt. You may wear shorts underneath the skirt. You will need a head scarf for this church. We have some gypsy scarves in our closet and there are some scarves at the Sikh Center if we don't have enough. However, if you have a head scarf, please bring it. It does NOT have to

cover all of your hair, but must cover the top of your head, and most of your hair. Both men and women need head scarves. Sikhs are the men who wear turbans.

Wash your feet before you come because you will be taking off your shoes for the service.

In this Sikh Center the worshipers sit on the floor and both men and women cover their heads. The language in the service is Punjabi, but it is translated into English on the screen in front. The service we attend will be led by the youth groups of the Sikh Center. Both Dr. O and I have attended this church and liked it very much. Dr. O. knows several of the doctors at CHOC who are members of this faith. You can expect to hear singing and drums, and it is very different from other churches we have attended in the past.

Go-To-Church Service is required attendance for the perfect attendance award at the end of term.

NOVEMBER 20: FAREWELL MEETING: Regular Friday meeting.

Arrive at 6 PM with ALL of your Bethel paraphernalia. Mariya is in charge of FAREWELL and she will be doing an early practice with all of you (except Brittany).
